This concert is the first of a new series of New Music concerts hosted by Compositum Musicae Novae. New chamber works by several Miami-based composers will be featured, along with a poetry reading by Meli Coedo, and an art exhibit by local Miami artist Alysia Rodriguez.

Featured works of the night will include *Aldulindalë, Song of Two Trees*, for Piano, Cello and Flute, by Hungarian composer and resident Musicologist at New World School of the Arts, Dr. Lajos G. Zeke.

The night will also feature a United States premiere of two guitar duets and a guitar and flute duet, by Cuban guitarist and composer Ray Guerra. Guerra is an internationally recognized musician, known for placing first, on two separate occasions, in the Amadeo Roldán National Guitar competition. He has also won at the Markneukirchen International Guitar Festival.

Other chamber works by several local Miami art music composers will be presented, including pieces for solo cello, solo piano, four hand piano, piano and clarinet, and piano and voice.
